There is a drop off point behind the theatre in a layby on Great George Street (LS1 3DW).

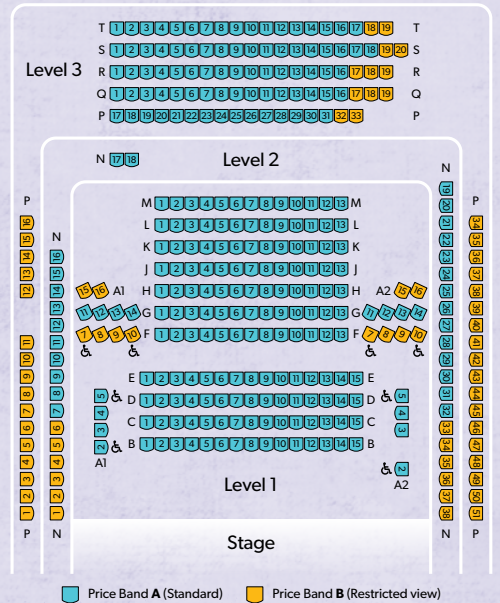
