

## CYTM Behaviour Policy

By joining CYTM you consent to abide by the following behaviour policy.

If a CYTM member disrupts the session or behaves in an inappropriate way or a way which disrupts another young person's enjoyment of or participation in the activities, they will be issued with a warning. At the end of the session, we will inform the young person's parent or guardian.

If a CYTM member receives two warnings their parent or guardian will be invited to discuss their behaviour at a meeting with the CYTM Artistic Director. At this meeting we will try to find a way to prevent the behaviour continuing and to reconcile any differences between CYTM members. If we are unable to do so we reserve the right to exclude the young person.

CYTM reserves the right to withdraw the place immediately, without warning, of any young person who is aggressive, verbally or physically, to another young person or one of our team, or if any young person is found to be bullying another. Refunds will not be offered in these circumstances.
