Carriageworks Theatre Access Information Guide

Leeds City Council aims to provide an accessible and inclusive facility for all events taking place in the Carriageworks Theatre.

The main entrance to the theatre is situated on Millennium Square within The Electric Press. You will find our ticket office, Leeds Ticket Hub, here on the ground floor. From the entrance on Great George Street, through The Electric Press Courtyard, there are 6 steps to the ground floor ticket office and a lift to all levels.

Lift access is available to all levels: -0, Ground Floor and Levels 1 – 4.

An accessible (M/F) toilet with baby change facilities is available on levels 1,2,3 & 4

Bars on Level 1 and Level 2 are open to visitors prior to and during performances.

The Main Auditorium has eleven wheelchair spaces available on Level 1.

The Studio, a small-scale black box space, on Level 4, has four wheelchair spaces available, dependant on layout.

Support Dogs are welcome. Water bowls supplied.

Tickets can also be purchased or collected in person from the ticket office on the ground floor from two hours before any show begins at The Carriageworks Theatre.

Parking

Street parking and secure car park options available nearby include:

1. **Portland Crescent Car Park** pay and display short stay. Located off Portland Crescent near Leeds Civic Hall, Portland Crescent. Open all day with a maximum stay of 5 hours before 6pm.
2. [The Light Multi Story Car Park](#) long stay open 24 hours, 7 days a week. Located via Dudley Way off Great George Street on the Leeds City Loop.
3. [St. John's Shopping Centre Multi Story Car Park](#) long stay. Open 24 hours, 7 days a week. Located off Merrion Street on the Leeds City Loop.,
4. [Woodhouse Lane Multi Story Car Park](#). Open 24 hours, 7 days a week. Located opposite Leeds Metropolitan University, with access from the inner ring road.

Drop Off

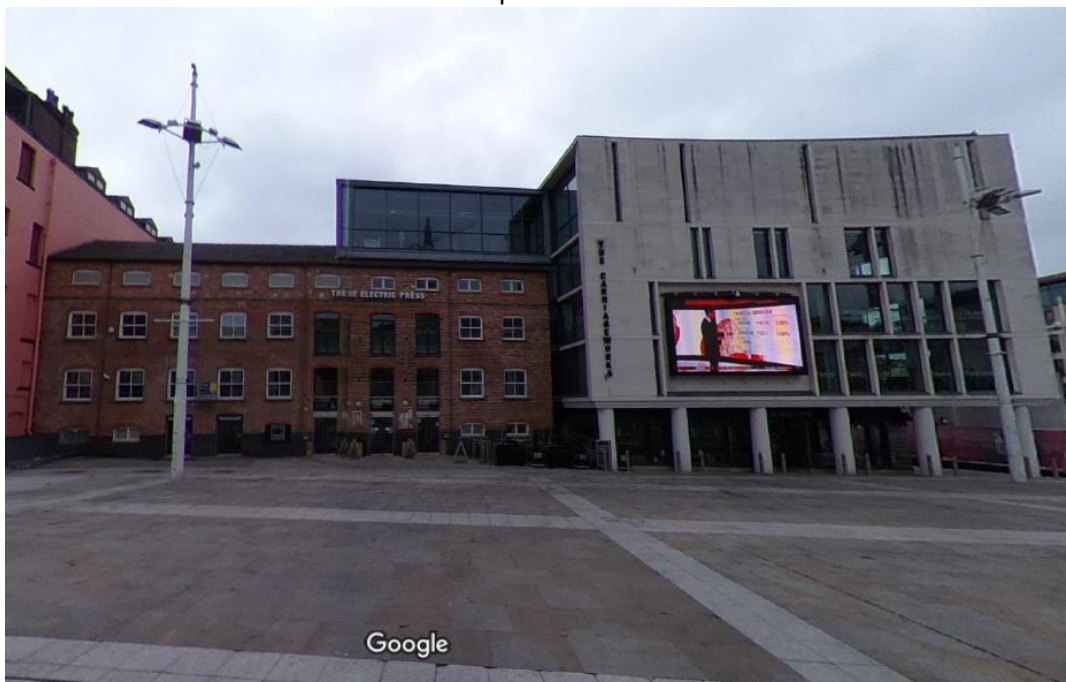
